WHAT WILL I LEARN?

This course is an intense (not that the name gives it away!) introduction into the world of wedding flowers. We will work through the basics of buttonholes, right through to the in depth mechanics of a wired headdress, all the while discussing clients, style, budgets and much more. You will leave the course with a vast range of new skills to practice and perfect.

This course is well suited for people with some floristry experience, those who have completed our "Introduction to Career Floristry" course, or are existing florists in business, looking for a boost!

THE THEORY

Of course the theory of things can feel a bit "boring" but it really gives a solid grounding for beginning your wedding floristry career, and is an essential aspect of our course - but we try to keep it fun!

Throughout the course we will discuss the following essentials regarding weddings:

- Tools, mechanics and equipment
- Ordering and pricing to fit a wedding budget
 - Time management and planning
- Delivering/transportation practicalities and expenses
 - Colour and texture combinations
 - Flower combinations to create the required style
 - The bridal consultation and booking process
 - Discussing contracts and Ts&Cs
- Case studies of scenarios encountered in the industry, and how you would try to overcome and deal with them in your own business

THE PRACTICAL

If you are wanting to perfect your skills, the best way to do this is to get hands on! Most of the arrangements and techniques we cover will be a demonstration, followed by you making your own interpretation! Others will be a demo to give you an insight into a certain technique, that is covered in depth on other courses of ours!

Below is a guide of what you can expect to learn! Anything with a * is a demonstration only item.

 - Shower bridal bouquet

WHAT IS THE INVESTMENT?

The cost of the course is: £1495
